



## NORMAL (1) Phenomenal. Generated by perception of physical space via sensors. (2) Memory. Replay of images experienced through sensors in the past. (3) Visualisation. Generated/controlled by imagination and creativity. (4) Dream space. Like memory/visualisation space plus other elements. PARANORMAL (5) Psi. Involves direct interaction between mental and physical space. (6) Apparition. Different from physical space but aspects of externality. (7) Threshold. Pseudo-physical experiences on border of sleep/waking. SPIRITUAL (8) OBE. Subtly different from physical space, changed by imagination. (9) NDE. Relates to OBE space but other spatial experiences involved. (10) Survival. Where 'soul' dwells after death or between incarnations. (11) Mystical. Various extrovertive experiences plus 'higher planes'.








FIG. 5. A. The whole person, biobodysuit metaphor. Each layer has a unique substance and infrastructure. The outer two layers constitute temporal physical reality. The middle shell is nontemporal and could be called the soul. The layer infrastructures and the coupling between layers largely determine the state of wellness







- · But who created may created the mutlierse?







Abrams explores a radically new way of thinking about God. She dismantles several common assumptions about God and shows why an omniscient, omnipotent God that created the universe and plans what happens is incompatible with science. ### MULTIVERSE AND RELIGION

"There are innumerable universes besides this one, and although they are unlimitedly large, they move about like atoms in You. Therefore You are called unlimited." (Bhagavata Purana 6.16.37)

Fakhr al-Din al-Razi (1149-1209) in the Matalib raises the question of whether the term "worlds" in a Qur'anic verse refers to multiple worlds within this single universe or to many other universes beyond the known universe.

"He the Most High has the power (qadir) to create a thousand thousand worlds (alfa alfi 'awalim) beyond this world such that each one of those worlds be bigger and more massive than this world, as well as having the like of what this world has of ..... the heavens (al-samawat) and the earth (al-ard) and the sun (al-shams) and the moon (al-gamar). The arguments of the philosophers (dala'il al-falasifah) for establishing that the world is one are weak, flimsy arguments founded upon feeble premises."








Most convincing evidence from children who recall and provide verified details of previous life




### IMPORTANT FEATURES

- Sometimes dying person wants to be reborn and announces this in dream to new mother.
- Children usually start talking about previous life at around 3 years of age and stop at around 6.
- Usually recall recent life, with typical interval of 16 months.
- Statements focus on end of life, 75% decribing how they died.
- Previous death unnatural (eg. accident) in 70% of cases or premature if natural.
- Previous lives very ordinary, usually nearby geographically.
- Many children show phobias associated with previous death or philias and talents associated with previous life.
- 35% have birthmarks associated with previous death.

### SOME EXAMPLES OF BIRTHMARK CASES

Postmortem report => within 10cm of wound in 88% of cases





Left: hypopigmented macule on chest of an Indian youth who, as child, remembered life of Maha Ram, killed with shotgun fired at close range. Right: circles show principal shotgun wounds on Maha Ram from autopsy report.



Severely malformed ear (microtia) in Turkish boy who remembered life of a man fatally wounded on the right side of the head by shotgun discharged at close range.



Almost absent fingers (brachydactyly) on one hand in boy of India who remembered life of boy of another village who had put his hand into blades of a fodderchopping machine and had his fingers amputated.



Congenital absence of lower leg (unilateral hemimelia) in Burmese girl who remembered life of young woman accidentally run over by a train, with her right leg being severed first.



Large verrucous epidermal nevus on head of Thai man who as child remembered life of his paternal unde, killed with blow on head from heavy knife.



### 18 of 210 cases involve double birth-marks





in man whose life he remembered who had been shot with rifle from behind.

Small, round puckered birthmark on Thai Larger, irregularly shaped birthmark on boy corresponding to entry bullet wound frontal area. This birthmark corresponded to exit bullet wound of man whose life he said he remembered.





### Manifesto for a Post-Materialist Science

Mario Beauregard

The modern scientific worldview is predominantly predicated on assumption of scientific materialism that matter is the only reality. But conscious mental activity can be experienced in near-death experiences, out-of body-experiences and in profound spiritual experiences. In 2014, a group of scientists from a variety of fields (biology, neuroscience, psychology, medicine, psychiatry) came together to challenge the materialist worldview at an International Summit on Post-Materialist Science. This resulted in a summary report, asserting that mind is fundamental in the universe, and cannot be derived from matter and reduced to anything more basic; that minds are apparently unbounded and may unite in ways suggesting a unitary one Mind that includes all Individual minds; that the evidence suggests the survival of consciousness following bodily death; and that scientists should investigate spiritual experiences since they represent a central aspect of human existence.
